Courses to take Summer 2016 to reduce your course load or time to degree:

- MECH&AE M20 (Intro to Computing: MATLAB): Requisite: Math 33A. This course is required for CH ENGR 109 which is offered in the Fall. If you do not take this course in the summer, your time to degree will be 3 years. This course will also be offered online.
- 2. Complete any missing prep courses (Math, Physics, Chemistry).
- 3. ENGR 183EW (Engineering & Society): Taking this course now will reduce future course load.

Summer Advising:

- If you are unable to attend orientation, you must sign up for email advising in order
 to enroll in courses for the fall quarter. Email <u>orientation@seas.ucla.edu</u> and notify us
 starting in mid-July that you cannot attend (include your name and UID).

Requisite Evaluations for Summer Enrollment:

- 1. For transfers from California Community Colleges: First check <u>assist.org</u> to see if the course you took at your community college meets the requisites for the UCLA summer course you are attempting to enroll in.
- 2. If you were unable to determine if you meet the requisite, that is listed for the UCLA summer course, then you may have your community college course(s) or a course taken at another school evaluated. Email course_eval@seas.ucla.edu to initiate a course evaluation request. Again, this process is only required if it is not clear on assist.org how your course transfers over.
